GALA Festival 2016, held July 2-6 in Denver, will be the 10th GALA Festival


Expecting over 6,000 singers to attend representing 150-160 choruses and ensembles.




The Denver Performing Arts Complex

One of the largest arts complexes in the world featuring 10 performance spaces connected by an 80-foot-tall glass roof.




Boettcher Concert Hall – 2,700 Seats








Concert Block Overview



- 30 minute set: entrance/exit time and all movement/transitions
- Movement of piano or instrumentalist will come out of your set time
- Stage set-up: grand piano, music stand and risers: 4 ft deep, 5 risers high (4 risers in Boettcher plus optional use of the parquet).

Morning Coffee Concerts

- Limited number of 50 minute performance sets
- Performed in primary concert halls
- · Can accommodate more complicated staging or instrumentation
- Chorus is responsible for any incremental backstage labor, sound, lighting costs incurred

If selected for a Coffee Concert this performance counts as your chorus' Festival performance.

Coffee Concert Timeline

Sept 2014	Coffee Concert application process is open. Application and details on website.
Jan 31, 2015	Coffee Concert applications due
Feb/Mar 2015	Committee reviews Coffee Concert applications
May 2015	Coffee concert participants selected and notified





Coffee Concert Selection

The application and audition for a Coffee Concert includes:

- Description of the proposed program, repertoire, performing forces and general technical needs.
- Choral score or a description of the work to be commissioned.
- Three (3) representative song recordings not to exceed a total of 15 minutes
- Three (3) representative concert programs

Criteria: applications that demonstrate

- unique and creative programming concepts
- · high artistic and musical quality
- the ability of the chorus to successfully perform the proposed program based on previous programming.
- connection to the mission of GALA Choruses


