# Stay Current on Events and Programs

#### Use the GALA 411 Advisors

The GALA 411 advisors are available to member choruses for mentoring on a variety of topics, including artistic direction, chorus management, board development, and more. # Attend the Leadership Symposium

Leadership conferences are held annually (except in Festival years) providing an opportunity for education, networking, inspiration, and just plain fun! The workshops cover topics of interest to artistic directors, chorus managers and chorus board members. The Leadership Symposium is hosted in a new city every year, and typically is scheduled for Presidents' Day weekend.

Festival is the signature event of GALA Choruses. Our next Festival will be held in Minneapolis on July 12-16, 2028. Starting early on fundraising for Festival is critical to having enough singers attend for your chorus to sound its very best.
